




For Architects:

- If the shelter is for concentrated assembly gatherings and is greater than 2100 sqft., the shelter will be upgraded to Risk Category III.
- If the shelter is for unconcentrated assembly gatherings and is greater than 4500 sqft., the shelter will be upgraded to Risk Category III.
- If the structure is adjacent (<20') to a Risk Category III building, it may have to be classified as Risk Category III.
- If the shelter is adjacent to a sprinklered building, it may have to be sprinklered as well.
- If the structure is installed in an area with seismic SDS values between 0.92 and 1.0, and there is not an available geotechnical report, the structure will be classified as Risk Category III.

- If a geotechnical report is not available, then Soil Class 5 (worst case scenario) will be used to determine footing dimensions.
- If the structure is < 4000sqft, then a geotechnical/geohazard report is not required unless the structure is to be installed within an earthquake fault zone or seismic hazard zone.
- If the structure is >4000sqft, then geotechnical and geohazard reports will be required for DSA submission.





For Architects:

- If the canopy is >1600 sqft. and <4000 sqft., a Geotech report is required when the project is submitted to DSA to verify that there is no liquefaction.
- If the canopy is >4000 sqft., then a Geotechnical/Geohazard report is required upon DSA submittal.




